

Bio for Bryan Rodgers, C.M.

Bryan Rodgers was named Director of University Park Airport in January 2004. As Director Bryan is responsible for the planning, development, operation, marketing and administration of all aspects of the University Park Airport including: business operations, human resources, airport operations, aircraft maintenance and repair services, special aircraft operations, physical plant operations and maintenance, construction planning and administration; governing, regulatory and funding agency relations; grant acquisition, administration and compliance and public relations.

From January 2000 – December 2003 Bryan served as an Assistant Airport Manager for the University Park Airport where he was responsible for the facility's federal and state capital improvement programs, grant acquisition; and management of airport development projects.

Bryan has been involved with aviation for 28 years beginning as a Regional Engineer with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) Bureau of Aviation in 1993. As a Regional Engineer Bryan was responsible for providing project management and technical assistance to airport sponsors, throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in support of PennDOT's Aviation Grant Programs.

Bryan graduated from Penn State, Altoona Campus in 1985 with an associate degree in mechanical engineering technology. He went on to earn a Bachelor of Science degree in structural design and construction engineering technology from Penn State at Harrisburg in 1988.
