  combination of education and closely related facilities management experience may be considered.
  An advanced degree is preferred.
- Knowledge of administrative principles and practices, including goal setting, program development, implementation and evaluation, and the supervision of employees; principles and practices of employee supervision, developing teams, motivating employees, and managing in a team environment.
- Knowledge of principles, practices, and techniques of facility maintenance in a public agency setting; materials and techniques of facility maintenance; budget development and administration; applicable laws, codes, and regulations.
- Knowledge of federal rules and regulations related to airport maintenance activities; computer applications related to the work.
