Professor Lou Scala began his career in aviation as a freshman at Aviation High School in 1965 where he earned his FAA Airframe and Powerplant Mechanic Certification. Lou continued his education at Farmingdale State College studying Aerospace Technology, and followed this by obtaining B.S. and M.A. degrees in Technical Education from New York University. In 1976, Lou began his teaching career as an aircraft maintenance technical instructor at Vaughn College of Aeronautics, and returned "home" to Farmingdale State College Aviation Department in 1982. During his tenure at FSC, he has taught many subjects related to aircraft and engine technology, the history of aviation, government regulations, and airport operations.
