

Chief Financial Officer The Kenton County Airport Board

Description: The Kenton County Airport Board is seeking a Chief Financial Officer (CFO) who will be responsible for directing the organization's financial planning (short- and long-term) and analysis, development and monitoring of operating and capital budgets, accounting, treasury and investment, securing funding, airline rate setting and related contractual relationships and KCAB relationships with lending institutions, bondholders and financial institutions.
