

Executive Director of Aviation The City of Killeen Department of Aviation

Description: The City of Killeen Department of Aviation is seeking an Executive Director of Aviation. The Director will be responsible for managing the two airports operated by the City of Killeen: the Killeen-Fort Hood Regional Airport (GRK) and Skylark Field (ILE). The Director will also have the responsibility to supervise airport personnel engaged in maintenance and operations of the airport; to fuel and service aircraft based or transiting the airport; to direct the planning of airport facilities and operations; to monitor federal and state airport regulations and insure compliance; and to market the airport to corporate and commercial aviation prospects. This position also exercises supervision of the employees in the Aviation Department.

Minimum Requirements:

- Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with a degree in aviation management, public administration, business management or related field; Master's degree preferred; and,
- Five (5) years of experience in airport management or a related aviation activity;
- Public sector experience, preferred.
- An FAA issued pilot's license or equivalent military aviation experience is desirable.
- A.A.E. accreditation by the American Association of Airport Executives is strongly preferred.

Salary/Benefits: The salary range for this position is \$99,000.16 to \$139,447.00. The City participates in the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS) at a 7% employee deposit rate with a municipal matching ratio of 2:1. A comprehensive benefits package is included.
