AAAE MEMBERSHIP FEE MATCHING GRANT
APPLICATIONS ARE ACCEPTED THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

One grant per Student Chapter will be awarded to cover half of the annual registration fees for membership in AAAE, up to the minimum 5 required dues paying members.

ELIGIBILITY: Student Chapters must submit Annual Report and proof of payment to the Academic Relations Committee Chair in order to be eligible for reimbursement of membership fees.

INTERNSHIP GRANT
DUE DATE: FEBRUARY 1 AND OCTOBER 1 OF CURRENT YEAR

Two \$1,000 Grants may be awarded a year. Hands on experience in an airport environment complements the Airport Management Student's educational experience. Internships are usually for three months but may be extended, on the mutual agreement of the airport and intern. Interns will be exposed to specific areas of airport administration on varying levels at an airport in good standing with the Chapter.

ELIGIBILITY: Students aspiring to a career in airport management or recent graduates wishing to gain experience in airport management.

DUE DATE: MARCH 1 OF CURRENT YEAR

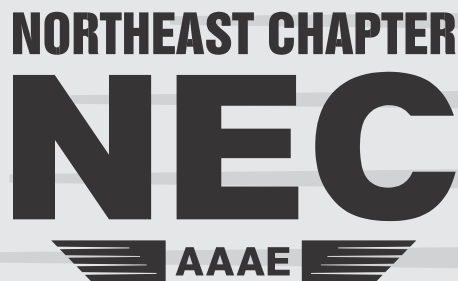
